Phase 1: Reflection and Discovery

Your goal in Phase 1 is to form a committee, review where you are with your previous plan, and determine your current inventory of supported devices.

- a) devices that are end of life and when they expire.
- b) as new devices come in please prepare your team for the expired devices to come out.
- c) be sure to plan for a learning focus for the technology with your team. Technology with purpose is transformational.
- d) consider your device storage options and those that can be reused or need replacement. Think of this through a safety lens.
