A #Fliphunt is a digital scavenger hunt that takes place on Flipgrid. You create tasks to engage students and challenge them to show what they know with video responses.

## FlipHunt's are great because:

- You can use them to differentiate for all content areas and learning goals
- They can include movement and collaboration
- They can be used for inquiry, review, and assessment
- They are creative, fun, and engaging experiences for students

## Teacher Tips:

- For this task, we recommend giving students 30 minutes to complete as many tasks as they can, but you can adjust this as you see fit for your class.

- If students have never used FlipGrid before, I would suggest doing a small intro activity with them before doing this FlipHunt.
- To use this FlipHunt, start by creating a FlipGrid Group for your class.
  - o Then create a Digital Citizenship Topic so that student can share their responses.
    - Make sure you set the max time for each video to 5 minutes or less.
    - Attach the file link (as Topic Attachment) for the Digital Citizenship FlipHunt this will give students a copy of the tasks to be completed.
  - Share the FlipGrid Topic with your students.
