

How do I complete a Core Competency Reflection in my Personal Growth Plan Portfolio?

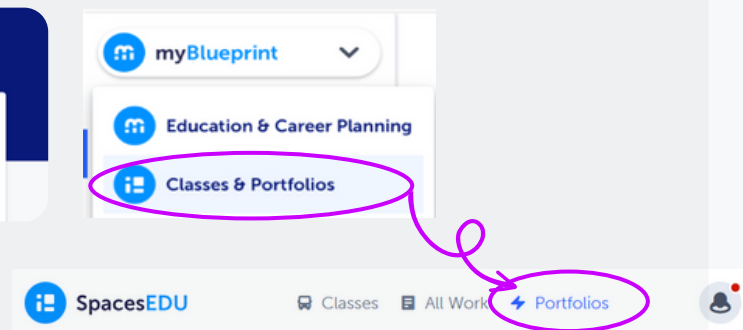
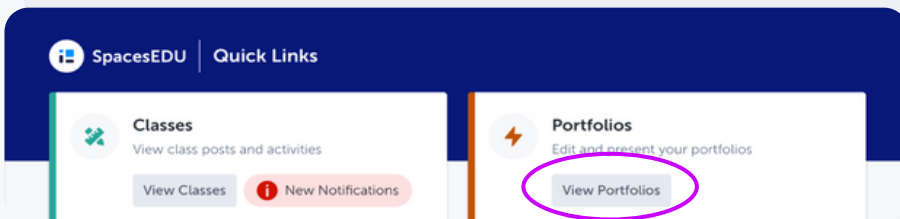


Your school has created a portfolio for documenting and reflecting upon your Core Competencies. Let's add to your Core Competencies portfolio!

1. Open your Portfolio

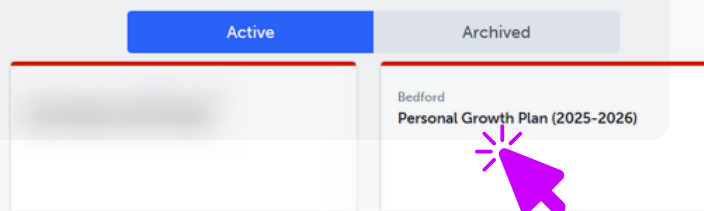


1. From your Dashboard, choose "View Portfolios" OR select Classes & Portfolios > Portfolios from the drop down in top right corner



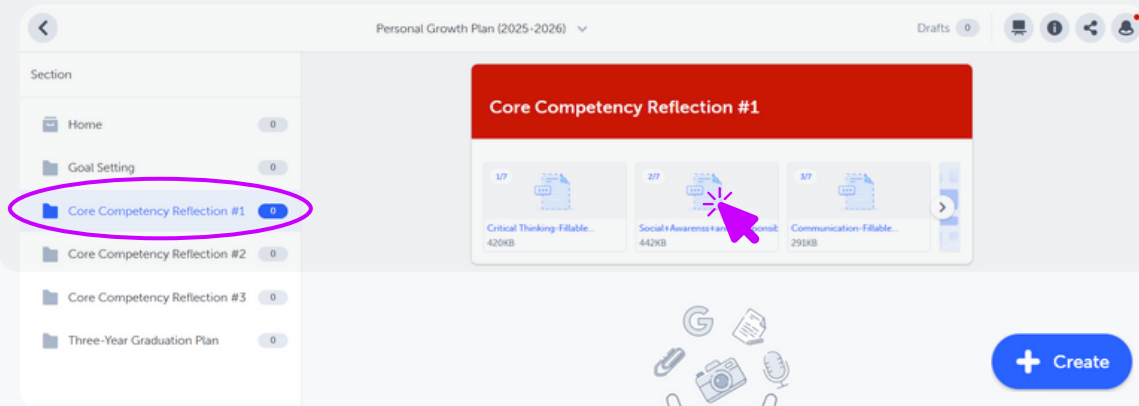
* If you are brought into your Class, after selecting "Classes & Portfolios", you can access your Dashboard by clicking on the Home symbol.

3. Read the instructions in the description and click "Get Started"



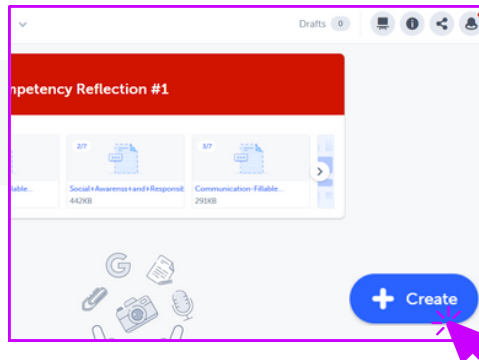
2. Complete your Core Competency Reflection Form

1. Click +Create in the bottom right corner

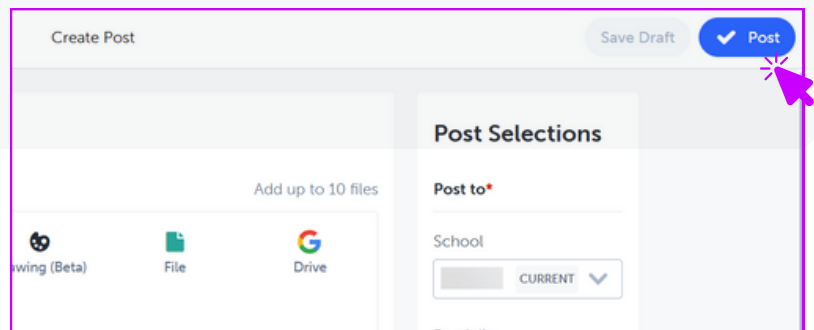


2. Under **Media** choose **File/Drive/OneDrive** to attach your completed Core Competency Reflection Form
